- A scan of my Language Proficiency Statement (signed and stamped, except for native speakers of English)
- A Photocopy of academic records in Dutch or English
- 1 clearly readable scan of passport or identity card
- 1 passport picture in JPG
- A scan of a valid health insurance policy in English (for EU students; EHIC). The EHIC/health insurance policy must be valid throughout the study period at Windesheim UAS.
- Full year students only: 1 photocopy of birth certificate, with an apostille or double legalisation.
Note: Original birth certificate is needed in order to register with the municipality.
- Design students only: portfolio of work
- Nursing students: the result of Hepatitis B titre test and MRSA result
- Students following the honours college programme: comprehensive motivation letter + C1 level of English
